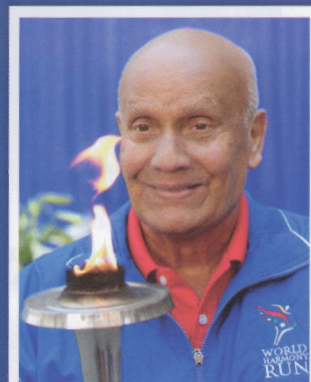

to all participants of the World Harmony Run, 2011 and beyond**

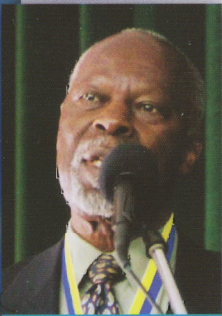
